

## 2012 Boys' All State Team

### 1st Team

Zach Gaugert 12 Waunakee

Parents are Tom and Heidi Gaugert. Coach is Craig Myers. Zach was the Badger Conference medalist for the season and posted a 36.83 season scoring average. An impressive season, Zach won the Neenah Invite and the Badger Conference Tournament at The Springs. He also lost in a three-way playoff at the Morgan Stanley Shootout at University Ridge. Zach shot 72 at regionals and qualified for state by shooting a 74 at the ultra competitive Onalaska Sectional good for third place. He then went on to shoot a 3 over 74-73-147 at the WIAA State Golf Meet which was good for 5th place. Zach will be golfing at Marquette next season.

Mitch Johnson 12 Middleton

Parents are Mark and Amy Johnson. Coach is Tom Cabalka. Mitch had a terrific 36.73 season scoring average which included medalist honors at Sheboygan North, Wisconsin Dells, Sparta, and the Big Eight Conference Tournament at Evansville. He was also medalist at the WIAA Regional event at Odana Hills and medalist at the Onalaska Sectional at La Crosse Country Club. Mitch shot a 77-72-149 good for 8th place in Division 1 at the WIAA State meet. Mitch will golf at New Mexico next season.

Henry Klongland 11 Stoughton

Parents are Scott and Molly Klongland. Coach is Dave Taebel. Henry had a 37.0 season scoring average and dominated his conference and invite schedule. He was medalist at the Viking/Spartan Invite, the Monona Grove Invite where he shot a 67, and runner up at the Badger Conference Tournament. Henry was third at the WIAA Regional event and 2nd at the Onalaska Sectional at La Crosse Country Club. He was second at the WIAA State tournament shooting an amazing 4 under par 73-67-140.

Jordan Niebrugge 12 Homestead \*Player of The Year

Parents are Rod and Judy Niebrugge. Coach is Steve O'Brien. Jordan repeats as the GCAW Player of the Year. He had a stellar 35.5 season scoring average where the lowest finish he had all season was a third place finish. Jordan won invitationals at Beaver Dam, Onalaska, The SVA, Cedarburg, and the WPGA event at Dretzka Park. He was WIAA Regional champ at Ozaukee and WIAA Sectional Champ at Washington County. Jordan finished off his impressive senior golf season by winning the WIAA State Division 1 title with an 8 under score of 70-66-136. Jordan will be playing golf at Oklahoma State next season.

Matt Ross 12 Arrowhead

Parents are John and Tammy Ross. Coach is Greg Budzien. Matt had a 37.29 season scoring average which included a 3rd place finish at the Classic Eight Conference tournament at Washington County. This was good enough to earn Matt his second consecutive conference player of the year award. Matt came on strong during the

WIAA Regional and Sectional events. He was medalist in each one including a great 69 at Wanaki in the regionals and then followed that with a 71 at Morningstar in the sectionals. Matt shot a 71-79-150 at the WIAA State Golf meet to help his Arrowhead team win the Division 1 title. Matt will golf at the University of Wisconsin next season.
