4. Treasure Report - Andrea still in Arizona, 2008-09 budget presented and checking balance presented. Andrea is still working on a tax ID #. Check's for miles/hotels were approved. Motion to approve - Mand / 2nd Menzel

5. Membership Report - 200 Members to this date, Taebel, Carlson & Johnson will work together to build numbers and add benefit for members. We will invoice AD's for the 2009-10 memebrship year. Carlson will be looking into courses willing to give WGCA member's discount's on golf. Updates list will be sent to Tony for the website. Motion to approve - Garth / 2nd Kyes

6. Web-Site Report - Impact sports will be a sponsor for \$1000.00. Academic all-state form will be updated. Tony will check to see what is will cost to have it work like the boys and girls all-state forms. Academic form will have the fax # changed to a email address.
