- 19. WIAA Report Adam McDonald
 - a) 1. Recommend during regular season and tournament play that the head coach be allowed to coach on the green without slowing down pace of play. Failed 3-11; Executive Staff -- No. The sentiment thus far is that pace of play needs to be greatly improved and that allowing coaches to coach on the greens will create even longer rounds. Also, coaches tend to focus on better

players to help with their putting and it is the weaker players who take more time and have more putts.

- b) 2. Recommend removing i. During the regular season and the WIAA tournament series, host schools must relocate as many forward and men's tees as necessary to create a women's length course that is approximately 15% shorter than the men's length course. Failed 0-14; Executive Staff -- No. There are other ways to get schools to start girls' golf programs. This regulation promotes girls to get involved in the game of golf at all schools.
